Student scholarship recipients are ambitious in nature as they are entering or currently enrolled in universities or colleges across the world. The selection criteria includes; young applicants who maintained an exceptional grade average, established an outstanding commitment to their community through leadership, volunteerism, overcoming obstacles, and

demonstrated interest in the mechanical contracting industry or their chosen field of study.

“Through this process, we meet insightful young leaders who are building a path forward to live their best life possible while elevating their own environments,” shares Wanda Heimbecker Association Manager, Mechanical Contractors Association Hamilton Niagara (MCAHN). Since 1995, an education investment geared to support young professionals continues to generate significant interest within this southern Ontario unionized construction employer network, proudly serving Hamilton, Niagara, Halton, Brant, Haldimand and Norfolk Counties. The MCA Hamilton Niagara McMaster University Student Chapter \$1,000 Scholarship managed by Dr. Stephen Veldhuis, Associate Professor and Director McMaster Manufacturing Research Institute, of the Department of Mechanical Engineering is also awarded. This year a tie introduced two lucky recipients, Jason Dales and Kristin Bennett.

This award emphasizes the importance of education and the desire to encourage women to enter the mechanical contracting industry while recognizing individuals who attain a high level of academic achievement
